1. What Mwavuli360 Is

Mwavuli360 is a plug-and-play compliance wrapper that connects to your existing system to enable you to submit claims to SHA.

Mwavuli360 sits between your facility system and the DHA/SHA ecosystem and handles the compliance layer on your behalf, identity verification, data mapping, encryption and automated claim submission.

2. Core Features

Four capabilities delivered by the middleware component installed at your facility.

01

Connection to the Client Registry

Verifies and resolves patient identity against the national Client Registry before a claim is raised.

02

Data compliance mapping

Maps your existing data fields to the required DHA/SHA schema, codes and formats.

03

Security & encryption compliance

Meets the transport and at-rest encryption, authentication and audit requirements set for facility-to-SHA data exchange.

04

Automated claim submission

Claims are packaged, validated and submitted automatically, with status returned to the facility.

3. Important to Note

Your existing data is retained.

Nothing is deleted, replaced or re-keyed.

You are provided an installable middleware component that:

1

Synchronizes data

Keeps your facility system and the compliance layer in step, in both directions.

2

Remediates historical records

Updates existing non-compliant records so historical data can be used going forward, where the source data permits.

Scope note: retrospective remediation depends on the identifiers present in your source records. Confirmed at assessment.

4. Wider Platform Capabilities

Insurance Provider Portal

Provider network management; claims intake; access control; reconciliation; TPA interfaces; API integration with insurer core systems.



Ministry of Health Dashboard

National health and traveller overview; public health indicators; provider visibility; aggregated claims; exports and reports.



API Gateway / Integration Layer

Connectivity to CRM and claims platforms and other approved system integrations.



Admin Portal

User and role administration; system settings; content and communication settings; reporting and reconciliation.



Cross-cutting health-data controls

Multi-language support; accessibility; data collection with sensitivity, privacy, retention and accuracy controls; 24/7 support.



Travel Health Insurance

Inbound traveller cover issuance and traveller claims handling on the same provider network and claims pipeline.
